Proposed motion:

That this Council permits the Cricket club to use part of the Village Field for the purpose of a Cricket Pitch and out fields, the Cricket Club can also work with the Football Club to utilise the same area for the purpose of a Football Pitch for the Youth Football Teams. Transition Kings Cliffe will continue to manage 2.5 acres of the Village Field, which has previously been allocated for the purposes of creating Bio Diversity within the perimeter of the Field. The Parish Council will enter into an agreement with the Cricket and Football club for this purpose and all works to be undertaken by the Cricket Club / Football Club will require prior agreement by the Parish Council.
