



"I have received the crime prevention in a box. There are 100 packs of material each to be given to the community. Emergency Working Group

CFRs continued to be called out and an application gone into Augean for small grant for kit.

Amenities Working Group

Oak Lane Common Project (Successful Grant for the fencing and works in the area). The CTP was previously agreed up to the £3,000 – The CTP for this project will be £2,800.

Street Lighting (L.E.D) Working Group

Cllr Meadows offered to arrange a meeting between Balfour Beauty and the PC to look further at converting all street lighting to L.E.D.

This was also previously discussed at Cllr Fairhall's community PCs meeting – some good feedback shared by other local councils and help offered by Clerks.

Cemetery & Church Yard Working Group

Trees – Clerk to request a quote by Richard Robinson for Pollarding and tree works. During September.

Leaning Gravestones and repairs to Memorials/ground – Clerk to now investigate this further working with the Working group.

Cemetery – IVY needs to be removed.

Church Yard – wild saplings (over the last 2 years) growing between graves - need removing or trimming – Clerk to link with Richard Robinson.
